Don't forget to sign up for your ONE MAIL Account if you haven't already. This is becoming more of an asset as many hospital systems will be relying on a secure hospital type email account for access. ALSO, you don't have to keep changing it, you can take it wherever you go! It can be used for secure exchange of personal health information about patients with others who have a ONE MAIL account or official Hospital email account. If you did not receive an email invitation within a month of starting your academic year, or if your invitation has expired and you would like to reactivate it, contact the Faculty of Medicine at onemail.help@utoronto.ca.
